



## **Device Compatibility Issues**

#### Key Issues Identified:

• Content Overflowing: Text and images spilling off-screen on mobile devices.

• **Button Scaling**: Buttons were too small on mobile, causing usability issues.

• **Navigation Differences**: Desktop navigation didn't translate well to mobile, requiring alternative methods.

Aesthetic Discrepancies: The mobile and desktop designs felt inconsistent and unpolished.

## Solutions Implemented

**Responsive Adjustments**: Fixed scaling issues for text, buttons, and images.

**Navigation Redesign**: Introduced mobile-friendly menus.

**Visual Consistency**: Unified aesthetics across all devices.

**Headshots Issue**: Replaced lengthy scroll with a slideshow function to improve usability.

## **User Testing Process**

#### **Test for Portability:**

- Unsupported capabilities and platform differences: desktop and mobile compatibility
- Test on different devices and browsers

#### **Test Plan Overview:**

- Comprehensive feedback collection
- Key participants included the client and the board of directors
- They evaluated the website and provided valuable insights for improvement
- Combined structured feedback collection, direct user engagement, and timely implementation of changes to ensure the website meets all project objectives
- Focus Group: Participants joined a small, interactive session online to provide direct, live feedback and discuss potential improvements
- Survey: Then shared their feedback on the website's functionality, design, and usability

- Add more photos and logos






## Feedback From Survey

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## **Adjustments Based on Feedback**

#### Implemented Adjustments include:

- Added a yellow gradient background
- Navigation bar with the colored header photo
- Added 6-8 photos to the slideshow
- Implemented device compatibility
- Edited the executive board section
- Awareness to the help4hearing project
- Awareness to the walk4hearing event
- The client noted that the website looks very good overall, with only minor adjustments needed.
- These initial results suggest that our approach has been effective in meeting the client's expectations. By addressing feedback from the client and board of directors, we are going to deliver a final product by the December 15th deadline.





10-pg Documentation

PURPOSE: Post-Launch updates to website

Have to understand our audience.

Framer is for non-tech savvy people, however we want to keep it simple for people who aren't in the field.

If something on the documentation doesn't answer the question, we refer to them to support or any resources. (Framer Documentation)

#### How to Update the Calendar for Events

- 1. Log into the HLAA Google Calendar account.
- 2. Add, edit, or remove events directly on the calendar.
- 3. Updates automatically reflect on the website through the calendar integration.

#### **Questions You Might Ask**

#### 1. How do I log into Framer to edit the website?

Open the Framer website, click "Log In," and enter the email and password
associated with the HLAA Chester County account. If you've forgotten the login
details, contact the website administrator for assistance.

#### 2. How do I update the text on a specific page?

 Navigate to the page you want to edit in the Framer dashboard. Click on the text block you want to update, and double-click to begin typing. Once finished, click outside the block to save your changes.

#### 3. How do I replace an image on the website?

 Click on the image you want to replace, then go to the Assets Panel on the right-hand side. Drag the new image into the panel and assign it to the image block by dragging and dropping it.

#### What if I make a mistake while editing? Can I undo changes?

Yes! Framer has an Undo button (located at the top of the editor), or you can
press Ctrl+Z (Windows) or Cmd+Z (Mac) to undo your last action. If you've
saved a mistake, use the History tab to revert to an earlier version of the website.
